5. Flowers or plants entered for competition must be more than ordinary standard and quality to be entitled to an award.

7. Exhibitor, except in arrangement classes, must grow all entries.
8. No exhibit may be removed at any time before the close of the exhibition except by consent of management.
9. The judge may withhold awards where they feel the entry is not worthy. The judge's decision will be final.
10. Exhibits must conform to the number of blooms, spikes or stems specified in each class.
11. Flowers in each entry must be one color and variety unless otherwise stated.
