**ENTRIES ACCEPTED:** Thursday, July 26, 2018 - 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM

1. To be judged on flavor, lightness, general appearance and crumb.
2. Exhibitor must have made all products. Premiums will not be paid for commercial products.
3. Complete baked goods must be brought to the fair. After judging, the fair will display only a portion of the product for the week. The rest of the baked goods will be sold at a "BAKE SALE" Thursday, July 26, 2018, at 8:00 PM; proceeds from the SALE will be used to improve the Home Economics Building.
4. Baked goods must be on paper plates and enclosed in plastic bags.
5. Only 1 entry per person, per class.
6. **Only classes listed will be accepted.**
