2024 Goat Regulations

****All exhibitors, at the time of animal check-in, must provide the Fair Office with a copy of their animals' health records. The health records will be kept by the Fair Office and will not be returned to the exhibitor.****

Pennsylvania Goats:

1. Individual official animal identification is required for all goats. Identification used for goats must be permanently affixed to the individual animal. Official ID includes any of the following:
 - (a) A USDA ear tag with a US shield; which includes scrapie program tags (animals bearing identification with blue colored scrapie program tags labeled "meat" with the US shield are not permitted be exhibited in Pennsylvania. Please call the department at 717- 772- 2852 if such a tag is encountered).
 - (b) A legible tattoo with herd and individual identification recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database a.k.a. scrapie tattoo (flock ID in the right ear--state postal code and letters/numbers--and individual animal ID in the left ear); or
 - (c) A breed registration tattoo if the animal is accompanied by a registration certificate and the tattoo is legible.
2. For post-exhibition sales the following requirements apply:
 - (a) Market goats must be documented on sales slips which contain the following information:
 - (i) Official identification (as described above)
 - (ii) Sale date
 - (iii) Sale location
 - (iv) Name, address and phone number of the exhibitor
 - (v) Hauler contact information
 - (vi) Destination name and contact information
 - (vii) Total number of animals in the shipment
 - (viii) Type of goat (i.e. meat, dairy, specific breed)
 - (ix) Signature of consignee, agent, or hauler
 - (b) Sales slips, or a document capturing all of the information required under subsection (a) above, must follow the sheep to their final destination (including slaughter facilities).
 - (c) Goats which are purchased with the intent of breeding and are traveling via interstate movement must have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) prior to movement to the destination state.
 - (d) A copy of the sale records slips as delineated above and a copy of any CVI, required under subsection (c) above, must be kept by the sale organizer for 5 years.
3. All goats shall comply with the Department's regulations regarding the intrastate transportation of goats found at 7 Pa.Code §§ 3.151).

4. All goats shall comply with the Department's "General Quarantine Order; Scrapie" [50 Pa.B. 4751, September 19, 2020].
5. A current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) valid for 30 days after the date of the issue.
6. All animals must be free of evidence of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this should be written on the CVI.

Out of State Goats:

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within the 30 days prior to entry into Pennsylvania.
2. Vesicular Stomatitis (VS) Statement: This applies to states that experienced a VS outbreak in the last 12 months. In these cases an accredited veterinarian shall determine whether the animals are free from VS, and animals shall be accompanied by a CVI with the following statement signed by the accredited veterinarian: "All animals identified on this CVI have been examined and found to be free from VS. During the past 90 days, these animals were not located within 10 miles of a site where VS has been diagnosed."
3. All animals must be free of evidence of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI.
4. Individual official animal identification is required for all goats. Identification used for goats must be permanently affixed to the individual animal. Official ID includes any of the following:
 - (a) A USDA ear tag with a US shield; which includes scrapie program tags (animals bearing identification with blue colored scrapie program tags labeled "meat with a US shield are not permitted be exhibited in Pennsylvania. Please call the department at 717-772-2852 if such a tag is encountered);or
 - (b) A legible tattoo with herd and individual identification recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database a.k.a. scrapie tattoo (flock ID in the right ear--state postal code and letters/numbers-- and individual animal ID in the left ear); or
 - (c) A breed registration tattoo if the animals are accompanied by a registration certificate and the tattoo is legible.
5. Tuberculosis testing requirements:
 - (a) No test is required for animals originating from states or zones designated as accredited-free by the USDA.
 - (b) All animals originating from states or zones designated modified accredited advanced by the USDA must be test negative within the 60 days prior to the date of importation. The negative test results and date of test must be included on the CVI or the animal must be accompanied by a negative test report (a copy of the original report is acceptable).
 - (c) All animals originating from states or zones designated modified accredited must originate from herds in which all animals 12 months of age and older have tested negative within the 12 months prior to the date of importation; and the individual animals (all ages) to be imported have also tested negative within the 60 days prior to the date of importation and at least 60 days after the negative whole herd test was completed. The negative test results and date of test must be included on the CVI or the animal must be accompanied by a negative test report (a copy of the original test report is acceptable).
 - (d) All goats shall comply with the Department's "Interstate Order of Quarantine; Tuberculosis Testing Requirements for Importation of Cattle, Bison, Goats or Camelids" [49 Pa.B. 709, Saturday, February 16, 2019).
6. For post-exhibition sales the following requirements apply:
 - (a) Market goats must be documented on sales slips which contain the following information:
 - (i) Official identification (as described above)
 - (ii) Sale date
 - (iii) Sale location

- (iv) Name, address and phone number of the exhibitor
 - (v) Hauler contact information
 - (vi) Destination name and contact information
 - (vii) Total number of animals in the shipment
 - (viii) Type of sheep (i.e. meat, wool, specific breed)
 - (ix) Signature of consignee, agent, or hauler
- (b) Sales slips, or a document capturing all of the information required under subsection (a) above, must follow the sheep to their final destination (including slaughter facilities).
- (c) Goats which are purchased with the intent of breeding and are traveling via interstate movement must have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) prior to movement to the destination state.
- (d) A copy of the sale records slips as delineated above and a copy of any CVI, required under subsection (c) above, must be kept by the sale organizer for 5 years.
7. All goats shall comply with the Department's regulations regarding the intrastate transportation of sheep found at 7 Pa.Code §§ 3.21-3.23 and 3.25-3.28).
8. All sheep goats shall comply with the Department's "General Quarantine Order; Scrapie" [50 Pa.B. 4751, September 19, 2020].

ENTRY DEADLINE: Friday, July 12, 2024

ENTRY FEE: \$2.00 per animal

ARRIVAL TIME: Monday, July 29, 2024 - 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon

RELEASE TIME: Saturday, August 3, 2024 - 11:30 PM

1. To show ownership, the exhibitor's name must be on registration papers.
2. If livestock barns are filled to capacity, entries will be refused based on latest postmark.
3. All goats must be registered in the exhibitor's name and stamped by the A.D.G.A. Papers must be readily available prior to and during the show.
4. All animal must be dehorned. Scurs will be permitted.
5. Goats must be milked prior to showing. Milk out time is twelve hours prior to the start of the show.
6. Exhibitors limited to 2 premiums per class; group classes limited 1 premium per exhibitor.
7. No straw or bedding will be furnished.
8. The co-chairpersons will handle all pen assignments. Barn capacity and assignments will be based on 3 large, 4 medium, or 6 small animals per pen.
9. Breeders are to be aware that the fair will not provide separation barriers for animals from certified scrapie free programs.
10. All goats must show in the age classes to be shown in the group classes.
11. This is an A.D.G.A sanctioned, combined Jr. & Sr. Doe show. A.D.G.A rules shall govern.

1. Each registered, purebred animal must be registered in the name of the exhibitor only.
2. This show will follow ABGA rules.
3. Does may be entered in Purebred/Full Blood and Registered Percentage categories.
4. Bucks are limited to Pureblood/Full Blood category ONLY.
5. Purebred animals may not be entered in Percentage classes.
6. The base date for computing ages for entries shall be the date the animals are judged.
7. Papers must be in exhibitor's possession at the time of the show.
