#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

ENTRIES ACCEPTED: Monday, July 28, 2025 – 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

- 1. Only 1 entry per person per class.
- 2. Exhibitor, except in arrangement classes, must grow all entries.
- 3. Plants will not be accepted for exhibition unless they have been growing in containers for 2 months.
- 4. Baskets or containers must be supplied by exhibitors and will be given every possible care, but the management assumes no responsibility for their safety.
- 5. The use of artificial flowers is prohibited and no premium will be paid.
- 6. Flowers or plants entered for competition must be more than ordinary standard and quality to be entitled to an award.
- 7. The judge may withhold awards where they feel the entry is not worthy. The judge's decision will be final.
- 8. The management may, at any time, order the removal of any exhibit that is in bad condition. Any article visibly unfit to show may be excluded.
