2026 Goat Regulations

****All exhibitors, at the time of animal check-in, must provide the Fair Office with a copy of their animals' health records. The health records will be kept by the Fair Office and will not be returned to the exhibitor.****

Pennsylvania Goats:

1. A current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) valid for 30 days after the date of the issue.
2. All animals must be free of evidence of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this should be written on the CVI.
3. Individual official animal identification is required for all sheep and goats. Identification used for sheep and goats must be permanently affixed to the individual animal. Official ID includes any of the following:
 - (a) A USDA ear tag with a US shield ; which includes scrapie program tags (animals bearing identification with blue colored scrapie program tags labelled "meat" with a US shield  are not permitted to be exhibited in Pennsylvania). Please call the Department at 717-772-2852 if such a tag is encountered).
 - (b) A legible tattoo with herd and individual identification recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database (Scrapie tattoo - flock ID in the right ear, state postal code and letters/numbers and individual animal ID in the left ear).
 - (c) A breed registration tattoo if the animal is accompanied by a registration certificate and the tattoo is legible.

Out of State Goats: Please contact the Fair Office or the PA Department of Agriculture for additional health rules.

General Information

1. For post-exhibition sales the following requirements apply:
 - a. Market sheep and goats must be documented on sales slips which contain all of the following information:
 - (i) Official identification; (ii) Sale date; (iii) Sale location; (iv) Name, address, and phone number of the exhibitor; (v) Hauler contact information; (vi) Destination name and contact information; (vii) Total number of animals in the shipment; (viii) Type of sheep or goat (i.e., meat, dairy, specific breed); (ix) For sheep, face color; (x) Signature of consignee, agent, or hauler
 - b. Sales slips, or a document containing all of the information required under subsection (a) above, must follow the sheep or goats to their final destination (including slaughter facilities).

- c. Sheep or goats which are purchased with the intent of breeding and are traveling via interstate movement must have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) prior to movement to the destination state.
- d. A copy of the sale records slips as delineated above and a copy of any CVI, required under subsection (c) above, must be kept by the sale organizer for 5 years.

ENTRY FEE: \$2.00 per animal

ARRIVAL TIME: Monday, August 3, 2026 - 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon

RELEASE TIME: Saturday, August 8, 2026 - 11:30 PM

1. To show ownership, the exhibitor's name must be on registration papers.
2. If livestock barns are filled to capacity, entries will be refused based on latest postmark.
3. All goats must be registered in the exhibitor's name and stamped by the A.D.G.A. Papers must be readily available prior to and during the show.
4. All animal must be dehorned. Scurs will be permitted.
5. Goats must be milked prior to showing. Milk out time is twelve hours prior to the start of the show.
6. Exhibitors limited to 2 premiums per class; group classes limited 1 premium per exhibitor.
7. No straw or bedding will be furnished.
8. The co-chairpersons will handle all pen assignments. Barn capacity and assignments will be based on 3 large, 4 medium, or 6 small animals per pen.
9. Breeders are to be aware that the fair will not provide separation barriers for animals from certified scrapie free programs.
10. All goats must show in the age classes to be shown in the group classes.
11. This is an A.D.G.A sanctioned, combined Jr. & Sr. Doe show. A.D.G.A rules shall govern.

1. Each registered, purebred animal must be registered in the name of the exhibitor only.
2. This show will follow ABGA rules.
3. Does may be entered in Purebred/Full Blood and Registered Percentage categories.
4. Bucks are limited to Pureblood/Full Blood category ONLY.
5. Purebred animals may not be entered in Percentage classes.
6. The base date for computing ages for entries shall be the date the animals are judged.
7. Papers must be in exhibitor's possession at the time of the show.
8. When livestock barns are filled to capacity entries will be refused based on latest postmark.
9. Exhibitor limited to 2 premiums per class.
