



2026 Fayette County Fair General Rules and Regulations

1. All exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of the Fayette County Fair.
2. All persons who enter the Fairgrounds and use the facilities on said grounds for the purpose of exhibiting, displaying, competing, or in any manner participating in the Fair, do so at their own risk. The Fayette County Agricultural Improvement Association will not be liable for any personal injury or property damage suffered by any person visiting the Fair irrespective of how such injury or damage occurs.
3. The Fayette County Agricultural Improvement Association will not intentionally show or permit to be shown any dangerous attractions on the grounds. However, the showing of certain attractions require that spectators be reasonably watchful of the conduct of children and though the Fayette County Agricultural Improvement Association will take every precaution, it will not be responsible for any personal injury or property damage suffered by reason of any attraction shown or exhibited during the fair.
4. Entries will be made according to classification. The Fair Management reserves the right to amend or add to these rules and regulations as it deems appropriate.
5. All exhibits must be the property of exhibitors at time of entry. Any exhibit not deemed worthy will not be placed.
6. Every effort will be made to protect all exhibits on display from any injury or damage. The Association is not responsible for any accidents, loss, damage caused by water, fire, theft or any financial loss.

7. Decisions of the judges are final. Premiums and ribbons will be awarded as stated in the catalog. In cases where there is only one exhibitor, judges may, at their discretion, give an award such as they deem the exhibit is worthy to receive.
8. Non-livestock exhibits may be removed at 10:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 8, 2026. All livestock exhibits, except as listed elsewhere in the catalog, may not be removed before 11:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 8, 2026. All exhibits must be removed by 6:00 p.m. Monday, August 10, 2026. Fruit, eggs and perishable food will not be kept after Saturday night, August 8, 2026. Failure to comply with release/removal times will result in the loss of premiums.
9. Premium checks will be mailed within 2 weeks after the fair. All requests for premium check corrections must be made by September 11, 2026.
10. The space for competitive exhibits is limited. The fair reserves the right to limit the number of entries in any department of the fair.
11. The fair reserves the right to remove any exhibit not worthy of viewing by the public.
12. During the judging, buildings, except livestock areas, will be closed to everyone except officials, judges, and necessary attendants. No exhibitor or his agent shall communicate with the judge during the time of determining the awards, except to answer questions proposed by the judges.
13. Exhibitors must review and follow department specific rules.
14. For the safety of all guests, firearms, weapons, fireworks, and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited.
15. The humane treatment of all livestock is required and shall include, but not be limited to, feeding, watering and caring for all animals in a proper manner as determined by show management.
