1. First hook fee is free. Any additional hook fees will be \$10 per hook.

GENERAL RULES:

1. All track official rulings are final.
2. Numbers will be drawn bingo style for pulling order. If number is already taken, contestant will be placed in the next available slot with a higher number.
3. Two class limit per tractor. **Subject to change at official's discretion*
4. ABSOLUTELY NO RIDERS ON THE TRACTOR. Drivers only on tractors.
5. First puller has the option to come back in third position (*driver must decide at the end of first hook*). If on their first pull, the driver loses a weight or goes over the speed limit, they will be disqualified, and their re-pull will be forfeited.
6. Driver has 75 ft. to decide to re-pull.
7. Tractor must have a hitch with a 3 3/4 X 3 INCH hole or clevis to pull from. Must have clear access to hitch from sled and hook must hang (not lay) on hitch.
8. Driver must obey flagman's signals at all times.
9. Tractor must meet approval of track official.
10. Tractors must have original shields and guards in place.
11. TRACTORS OVER 3000 RPM MUST HAVE CROSS BOLTS.
12. FIRST 3 CLASSES MUST BE SIGNED UP BEFORE DRIVER MEETING! (If you cannot be there in time, please have someone sign up for you).
13. *Wheelie Bars are recommended.*
14. Weights must be secured. The loss of a weight or any part from tractor results in a disqualification.
15. No bracket may extend forward more than 11 feet from center of rear axle.
16. Draw bar must be in a fixed stationary position. (No movement)
17. Driver must be at least 12 years old unless approved by track official.
18. Safe height of tractor front end from the ground is the flagman's discretion.
19. Tractor and weights cannot be altered in any way while on the track.
20. Four-wheel drive tractors may pull but front wheels must be in neutral.
21. No dual wheels or chains permitted.
22. Pull must start from a tight chain.
23. Driver is to remain with their tractor while in line and pull in order as sign-up sheet indicates; failure to do so results in forfeit of pull.
24. Track officials may stop a driver if tractor is being operated in an unsafe manner.
25. Driver must remain seated at all times; no jumping or leaning over back of seat.
26. Placing will be determined by the longest distance pulled; track official makes final decision.
27. No jerking of the sled or aggressive driving, on or off the track; this will result in a disqualification.
28. Only track officials and puller that is pulling are permitted on the track.
29. All tractors will be checked for modifications and safety.
30. No alcoholic beverages or drugs permitted on the grounds.
31. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification of tractor and driver for the day.
32. All protests are to be made to track official ONLY. Official will make decision whether or not protest is legitimate and whether or not a disqualification is necessary. DO NOT GO TO THE ANNOUNCER STAND!!

2. Maximum tire height 44".
3. No previewing of the track or mud pit will be permitted before pit gates open
4. The outdoor committee has the right to refuse any competitor or vehicle due to safety concerns
5. No rock climbers or bouncers of any kind
6. All vehicles have the right to be turned away due to superior horsepower and creating an unsafe environment in the arena
7. No passengers will be permitted to ride along in any vehicle in any class
8. Any vehicle with less than 4 cylinders may enter in the 4 cylinder class or the open. Competitors choice
9. Dune buggies will have the option to run in the open class or the side by side class.
10. Any cones knocked over will be a 10 second penalty per cone
11. All vehicles must have seatbelts or harnesses
12. Competitors must wear seatbelt or harness while running the course
13. All competitors must wear enclosed footwear (no sandals/flip-flops)
14. All competitors must wear a helmet while running the course
15. Any attempt to avoid the mud pit or ride the wall will result in a disqualification
16. Final times will come from the outdoor arena track crew. We will not accept or tolerate any controversy on times or placings
17. A vehicle may only run once in its registered class. Two drivers in the same class with the same vehicle will not be permitted. If two people desire to run the same vehicle the vehicle will have to be entered in two separate classes and pay the class entry fee for both classes no exceptions
18. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disqualification
19. Final decisions are in control of the outdoor committee co-chairs

401	Open Class: • All vehicles with no valid registration card • Drivers with no valid driver's license • Anyone is permitted to enter this class no matter the classification of their vehicle (quads, lawnmowers, dune buggy, etc) • Any participant may elect to run in the open class opposed to their cylinder dedicated class (V8, V6, V4, quad/side by side) • All general rules apply
402	V8: • Vehicles must have a valid registration card • Drivers must have valid driver's license • Vehicles motor must be 8 cylinder • Vehicles with less cylinders or outside of the parameters of this class may not enter • All general rules apply
403	V6: • Vehicles must have a valid registration card • Drivers must have valid driver's license • Vehicles motor must be 6 cylinder • Vehicles with more or less cylinders or outside of the parameters of this class may not enter • All general rules apply
